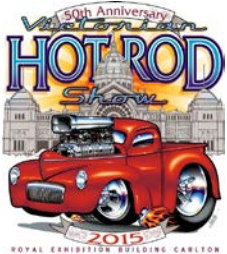

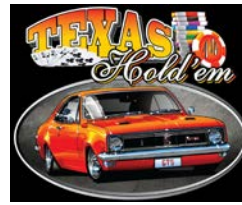

Special '10th Anniversary' Prize

We are excited to announce that the mystery prize we alluded to in the recent Cruiser Newsletter mail out made possible by The Frankston Engine Centre is a custom built 'turn key' Chevrolet 350 engine. This is not just any engine, it's based on a 'seasoned' Vortec 4 bolt block then filled with hi performance crankshaft and rods, forged hi comp pistons, performance custom cam, topped off with Trick Flow performance alloy heads, roller rockers, an Edelbrock intake manifold and matched carby. Fitted out with a gear reduction starter and alternator supplied by Mark McDonald Auto Electrical from Carrum Downs, this 'turn key' ready to start engine is expected to produce around 400 BHP. Enough to light the fire in most cars. Valued at around \$7000, this engine is going to be won at next year's March Cruise Night by a very lucky *LGC Cruiser*.
