## **The Pirates Tavern**

You're welcome to enjoy the Pirates Tavern but as it is a licensed club, you'll need to sign in as a visitor.

The tavern is only licensed to serve alcoholic beverages from 12 noon. Please do not take any alcoholic drinks away from the Tavern and the bordered off area immediately outside. This is the only licensed area for consumption of alcohol on the Seaworks site and is regularly policed.

## Kid's Activities.

Lucky Card Game All kids arriving at Seaworks in an entrant's car will be given one playing card each. They need to keep this somewhere safe because at 1:30PM, along with the entrant's Poker game, they'll be invited to play 'Lucky Card Draw' for some great prizes.

## The Poker Game.

- You received your 2 playing cards at registration in Ann St. These were selected randomly after a shuffle from each deck used. They have your entrant's number matching your window sticker on the reverse side. You'll need these with you to play Poker at the 1:30 pm 'Flop'.
- At 1:30pm we'll "Flop" the remaining 3 cards in our poker game.
- Every entrant shares these three cards to make up their 5 card Poker hand.
- Combine your two cards with the 3 cards from the 'Flop' and if you have anything from a pair to a full house, then make your way to the winning hand judges. If you're not sure, head over to the judges anyway and they'll advise you.
- We have a major prize for the holder of the best overall hand and prizes for two runners up.
- Because we are using multiple decks of cards it's possible that there will be some weird and even duplicated hands.
- If we have more than one overall winning hand, we'll decide the result with a cut of the deck, high card winning.
- Judges decisions on what hands win are final.
- Important. Whether you're a winner or not DO NOT throw your two pre numbered playing cards away after the Flop. They just might win you \$500 at 3pm.

## The \$500 Entrant's Cash Giveaway at 3pm.

- After the 'Flop' concludes, take your cards to the LGC stand and place only ONE in the box provided, keeping the other matching card with your entrant number on it.
- Be back at the band stage at 3pm when we'll draw one card from the box. If you have the matching entrant numbered card, come forward so we can match up the two cards, then we'll ask you to bring your car to the front of the stage. We'll match the winning cards to the windscreen sticker and if all's correct, you'll soon be waving \$500 in cash.

#### LGC Cruisers.

There will be two *LGC Cruiser* Draws at this event so make sure you get your name into the bucket at the LGC stand for some great giveaways. 1<sup>st</sup> draw will be the 1:30pm "Flop". The 2<sup>nd</sup> draw will be at 3pm when we'll draw another *Cruiser* name out of the box just before we do the \$500 draw.

## **Entrant Parking**

If there's one thing we'd like more of at Seaworks it's more space to host this event. With your assistance we can get around 240 cars comfortably parked without blocking egress or having them too close to each other. We'll do our best to accommodate your preferences but there isn't enough space inside the shed or the pier to accommodate everyone that would prefer to park in either and large cars can be difficult to manoeuvre on the pier, so we do ask for your cooperation when parking. Overflow parking for late entrants or arrivals will be in Ann St.

### **Pre Registered Entrants**

If you're a pre registered *LGC Cruiser* you are free to park anywhere that's available when you arrive. As the venue fills up, which we expect to happen by 11:00 am, we will have set aside an area to accommodate any later arrivals.

### **Restricted Parking Areas.**

Seaworks is adjacent the Water Police headquarters and they require a clearway to be maintained at all times to allow their patrol and rescue boats to be launched from the ramp next the pier. It is a condition of our use of Seaworks that this clear way from the rear of the Police station is maintained at all times and the reason why some very good parking spots must remain empty at all times. If you are asked to move your car from these areas by a LGC member or parking marshal please do so asap.

## Things to do in Nelson Place.

There are many cafes, pubs, restaurants and shops all a short stroll back along Nelson Place. There's also a craft market in the Park and the Gem Pier to check out. You can use your entrant's playing card as a return entry ticket at the public entry or get a pass out stamp as you exit from the door at the Nelson St end of the main building. Make sure you're back at 1:30 pm for the "Flop' and 3pm \$500 draw though.
