LGC Cruiser Prize We are excited to have on display the major prize in this year's LGC

Cruiser Grand Prize Pool. This Hi Performance Chevrolet 350 engine, custom built by The Frankston Engine Centre is based on a 'seasoned' Vortec 4 bolt block that's filled with a balanced rotating assembly, with new bearings, SpeedPro



+.30 flat top pistons and a Clive custom hydraulic roller cam completing the short block. Engine builder Dave Butcher has topped the block off with a set of Edelbrock E Street heads delivering a 10:1 comp ratio. Roller rockers, an Edelbrock intake manifold and matched carby complete the top. ARP bolts have been used throughout the build. Fitted out with a gear reduction starter and alternator supplied by Mark McDonald Auto Electrical from Carrum Downs, this ready to start engine is built to produce a streetable 350 to 400 BHP. It just needs some finishing additions to be ready for the draw at the March Cruise Night. The only way to have this hi performance engine sitting in your engine bay is to take out an annual subscription as a LGC Cruiser.
