- Clive custom hydraulic roller cam.
- Edelbrock Aluminium E Street heads and matching intake manifold.
- Roller rockers, hardened push rods
- MSD HEI Distributor, Taylor Leads, ACDelco plugs
- Double Pumper carburetor, Hi flow air cleaner
- Low mount hi output alternator
- Gear drive starter
- ARP bolts have been used throughout the build.
- The engine is ready to start with fuel and electrical connections.
- Engine builder Dave Butcher expects this engine to produce a very streetable 350 to 400 HP.
