Developments at The Homemaker Centre

You may have read in the local papers details of upcoming developments at our Cruise Night venue. The development involves the construction of a building extension in the far corner of the car park [previously a Home Building Centre] to house a new Aldi Supermarket. This will reduce available car parking spaces adjacent this store. The other element is a new 'Family Style' Restaurant to be constructed in the middle of the car park roughly in line between Goodguys & Harvey Norman. Again, this will have both a short term and long term impact on car spaces we have used in the past for our cruise night. Construction on both projects is planned to

Construction on both projects is planned to commence before year end.

The new restaurant will be operated by Warren and the crew from the Sober Mule and will offer greater choice of food & beverage than is possible from the current cafe. It'll also provide greater seating both indoors and out for enjoying a meal.

For now, we'll have to accommodate the loss of spaces during construction and we'll assess the centres ability to host our cruise nights after the two projects completion. Hopefully these developments will make it an even better venue.
