Developments at The Homemaker Centre

It's taken a while to get started but as you will notice the building development is well underway. It is expected to run until mid year. We will still have around 200 car parking spaces available with some additional spaces in the area in front of BCF which we have not needed to utilize in the past. This should allow us to host the numbers that have been cruisin in over the past months. We ask for your assistance as we find a space for everyone when we're getting close to full.

If you are coming to the cruise night in a late model car we'd appreciate it if you can park outside the area we set up for the cruise night entrant's cars.

The development involves the construction of a building extension in the far corner of the car park [previously a Home Building Centre] to house a new Aldi Supermarket. The other element is a new 'Family Style' Restaurant to be constructed in the middle of the car park roughly in line between Goodguys & Harvey Norman. This construction will have both a short term and long term impact on car spaces we can have use, but will provide a new family style restaurant that can provide a full meals menu with sit down dining options. The new restaurant will not be open to the public on Tuesday nights and will only open for our cruise night, hopefully resulting in an even better venue for our Cruise Night.
