LGC Upcoming Events Cruise to Phillip Island Historic Races Saturday March 18th




We are again hosting a cruise to the Phillip Island Classic, our favourite motorsport event, on Saturday March 18th. *Note that*

this date is the weekend after the Labour Day Holiday weekend over when this meeting has been held in recent years. Over 500 cars have been entered with a number of cars coming from the UK and Europe. We will again cruise from Tooradin on the Saturday morning in convoy to the Grand Prix track. Cruise entrants park in a reserved prime location trackside in front of the Expo centre and next to the pedestrian bridge to the pits. All LGC cruise entrants receive a programme saving a further \$5. Entry cost is \$10 for LGC Cruiser subscribers, \$15 for non LGC Cruisers [Car & Driver] and all adult passengers. Children continue to be free. This is a considerable saving over the \$35 entry at the public gate price. This cruise has been a popular event on our calendar with many entrants coming back year after year. Numbers are capped by the reserved car park area.
